Ordering your child's Year 12 resources with Box of Books

We are pleased to announce our continued engagement with Box of Books for the provision of digital and physical education resources for the 2024 academic year. The Year 12 2024 booklist is now open for you to complete your order.


Students will have access to prescribed digital textbook resources from the first day of term via their Box of Books account. The school will pre-purchase these resources on your behalf.

'Mandatory' and 'optional' **physical books** are available for purchase as indicated on the booklist. While optional physical resources are not mandatory to purchase, a significant discount is offered on these titles, should you wish to do so.

Please note orders placed for **physical books** and resources before Friday 8 September 2023 will be delivered by the commencement of Year 12 ATAR courses on Monday 30 October 2023. However, please note that most resources will not be required in full until the commencement of the 2024 school year, meaning there is still plenty of time to place orders.

Steps to order:

- 1. Visit <u>Box of Books Shop</u> to log into your existing parent/guardian account or create a new account if it is your first purchase.
- 2. Add each student, including school email if possible, and nominate school and year group
- 3. Select the items you wish to purchase from the booklist shown
- 4. Use the checkout to organise postage direct to your nominated address and complete payment
